



Kenton 4-H Poultry Egg Drop & Judge a Fowl Assignment

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Due at our next scheduled meeting, or packet pick up!

1. Poultry handout provided. Use the kit provided to create a device to protect a falling raw egg. If you are permitted – video your drop. Written entries are also acceptable.
2. For this assignment you will want to let the audience know how high you dropped the raw egg from. Explain if/why your device was successful. You can write or record your efforts.
3. Using the chicken graphic or if you video you can use your own chicken at home if you choose. Explain to the average person why judges comment on specific body parts. If you are uncertain, a suggestion is to watch a video of a show online and listen to judge comments.
4. Please write on a second sheet of paper or on your poster board at least five points that a judge will comment on or evaluate on a poultry animal. If you have a turkey – and you want to complete this project about your turkey – or other fowl project that is acceptable.
5. Neatness counts, the adults reading will have to be able to read your explanations.
6. Your name, Kenton County, lower right corner
7. The club will provide prizes to those who complete the assignment!
