

# Bird Feeder

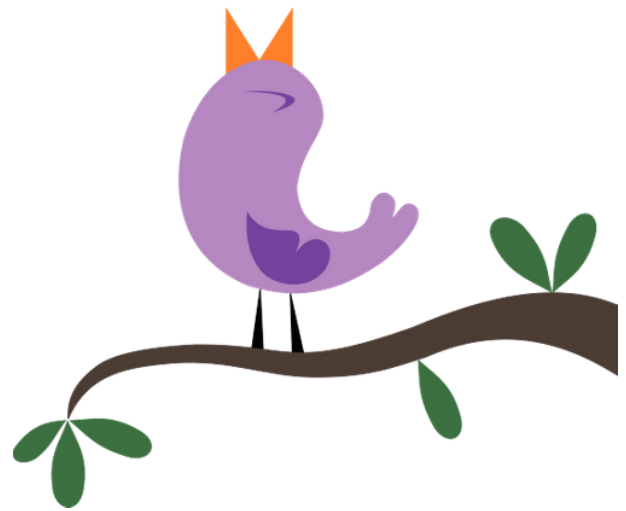

## Materials

- \* Several large pinecones or cardboard tubes
- \* Peanut butter (vegetable shortening for people with nut allergies)
- \* Birdseed
- \* String, pipe cleaners or wire
- \* Scissors (if using string)
- \* Butter knife
- \* Plate
- \* A place to hang your bird feeder (a tree or bird feeder hanger works nicely)



## Instructions

1. Gather some pinecones or cardboard tubes.
2. Attach your string or pipe cleaner to your pinecone or cardboard tube.
3. Pour some birdseed onto your plate.
4. Using the butter knife spread the peanut butter or shortening onto your pinecone or cardboard tube. Don't be afraid to get messy!
5. Once the pinecone or cardboard tube is covered with peanut butter or shortening roll the pinecone or cardboard tube in the birdseed.
6. Hang your birdfeeder!
