
## **String Art**

## Supplies:

- wood block, canvas, cork board, foam shape or foam board
- school glue or tacky glue
- printed pattern or stencil
- stick pins, tacks, nails
- hammer (if using nails)
- embroidery floss or yarn
- needle nose pliers


## **Instructions:**

- Get your supplies and cover your workspace
- Tape your template to your foam (or whatever you are using)
- We used a push pin to mark all the dots on our template and then removed the template
- Dip your pins in glue and put in the hole you made earlier and allow glue to dry.
- Once you've put all the pins in begin stringing.
- Start with tying a knot around a pin and have fun!
