Spe □	elling & Punctuation Use correct spelling and punctuation.
Act	Make sure to clearly identify what the project is. Tell why you chose to do this 4-H project. Describe how the project was made or accomplished. Make sure story is orderly, factual, and detailed. Include at least three (3) skills you learned in your story, the more details, the better. Tell who helped with the project and explain the importance of that help. What are two (2) goals you wanted to accomplish this year in 4-H? Did you meet the two (2) goals you set at the beginning of the year? Why or why not? How has 4-H impacted your life?
Sto	Have at least three paragraphs, including an introduction, a body, and a conclusion. Have a catchy beginning that introduces the project or accomplishment. Use complete sentences.

The story and record book must be the 4-H'ers own original work.
