- Applicant must present a tuition receipt prior to disbursal of any funds.
- The scholarship may be received only once.
- Independent judges from other counties will select the recipient.
- Other scholarships and grants received will be considered as a secondary factor.
- The scholarship will be awarded at the annual recognition event and the check will be made out to the individual recipient.
