

- market beef

- sheep (market and commercial)
- goats (market and commercial)

must be validated at an in person and receive a KUIP tag!

INFORMATION YOU NEED ABOUT

Directions to Enter 4-H/OPEN Projects for the Kenton County Fair

- All 4-H youth (age 9-18) who want to enter projects must turn in Record Book by 4:30 p.m. on July 7 to the Marshall Road and register the record book online at: kentoncounty.fairentry.com.
- All 4-H Fair Building/Open Building Projects must be entered in the Fair Entry system at: kentoncounty.fairentry.com by 4:30 p.m. on July 7. After you have registered your projects, email mary.cannon@uky.edu and she will print your fair tags.
- Social Security numbers will be required. Only the fair administrator can see this number and it will only be used for State Fair participants.
- Our office will be happy to help you learn the online system by appointment only.
- Youth must enter all projects online by 4:30 p.m. on July 7.
- Sunday, July 13th is a drop off day only. You will bring your projects to be judged. You must register your projects ahead of time and have the proper tags on them when you arrive on July 13th.
- You WILL NOT be able to enter your projects into the Fair Entry system on drop off day, July 13th if you don't enter them by 4:30 p.m. on July 7.

Fair Tags will be printed and can be picked up at the Marshall Road Office on July 9-11 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

RECORD BOOK REQUIREMENTS

In order to enter projects at the Kenton County Fair, you must meet the following requirements:



Record Books/scoring guidelines are in the Kenton County Extension Office lobby or on the website. 4-H'er must complete a Building/Companion Animal record book and/or Market Animal record book.



You must include a project achievement story. Reminder: the stories must be the child's original work.



All record books are to be logged in before 4:30 p.m. on Mon. July 7 & entered online at kentoncounty.fairentry.com. As always, record books will be accepted during office hours in the weeks prior to the deadline.



Record Books are available at kentoncountyextension.org. Fill it out, save a copy on your computer, and print it off for submission



Be sure to include your record book(s) when you enter other projects in the Fair Entry system: kentoncounty.fairentry.com

ATTENTION CLOVERBUDS:

Cloverbuds will NOT enter their projects online. They will bring their projects to the Fairgrounds and fill out an entry form at the fairgrounds. If you would like a cloverbud entry form early, email Mary at: mary.cannon@uky.edu

Cloverbud Entries for the Fair

Entry tags are not needed for Cloverbud projects. An entry sheet will be provided at the fairgrounds for you to fill out. You can call the office to ask for one prior to the fair.

- 1. Tomato any variety, plate of 3 large or 6 cherry
- 2. Cucumber plate of 3
- 3. Beans plate of 12
- 4. Corn any variety, plate of 3
- 5. Vegetable Plant grown in container
- 6. Flowers 1 bloom, any variety, in small bottle with water
- 7. Sunflower 1 head, does not need to be mature
- 8. Houseplant or Hanging Basket
- 9. Forestry 5 leaves; pressed, mounted, and labeled with common name, where found, and date found
- 10. Jewelry necklace or bracelet
- 11. Geology 10 rocks or fossils; mounted and labeled with name of rock
- 12. Wood Science any wood item sanded
- 13. Photography 2 photos, any subject, mounted on
- 8 x 10 mounting or poster board
- 14. Foods plate of 5 cookies, any type
- 15. Knitting/Crocheting/Needlepoint/Cross-stitch/Crewel
- 16. T-shirts decorated
- 17. Weaving 1 item
- 18. Leather Craft 1 item
- 19. Folk Art 1 painted item
- 20. Nature Craft 1 item
- Ceramics 1 piece, stained or glazed
- 22. Drawing pen, pencil, crayon, markers, chalk, charcoal
- 23. Painting watercolor, oil, acrylic

New Rule: This year you will be limited to 10 photography entries only. That includes the Horticulture Photography as well. Please only 10 total pictures per child.



The Kenton County 4-H Recognition Points Log is a system for each 4-H'er to record everything they've done throughout the program year. A designated number of points are awarded for a variety of activities.

These logs are used to determine the outstanding boy and girl award that is presented each year at the 4-H Recognition Banquet. They are also helpful when applying for 4-H Achievement Forms. The 4-H Recognition Points Logs are available at the Extension Office in the foyer next to the record books.

Recognition Points Logs for the 2024-2025 year will cover from September 1, 2024, through August 31, 2025. All Recognition Points Logs are due to the Extension Office by 4:30 p.m. on Thursday, September 4, 2025.



Smashed Potatoes

Ingredients:

6 large baking potatoes Cooking Spray 1½ cups sliced fresh mushrooms

4 green onions, thinly sliced

6 ounces fresh spinach

1 Tablespoon canola oil

2 teaspoons Dijon mustard

34 cup light sour cream

1 cup 2% cheddar cheese shredded

½ teaspoon salt

½ teaspoon black pepper

Directions: Preheat oven to 400 degrees F.

Wash and dry potatoes. Spray the skins with cooking spray and pierce potatoes in several places with a fork. Place on a 13 by 18 inch baking sheet. Bake until tender, about 1 hour. Wash mushrooms, green onions and spinach. Heat oil in a skillet over medium-high heat. Add mushrooms and sauté for 6 minutes. Add the green onions and fresh spinach, sauté for 1 minute. Slice off top inch of each potato, leaving a ¼ inch border around the edge. Scoop out the flesh into a mixing bowl and mash. Add mushroom mixture, Dijon mustard, sour cream and $\frac{1}{2}$ cup cheese. Mix well and season with salt and pepper. Scoop mixture into potato shells and sprinkle with the remaining cheese. **Return** the potatoes to the baking sheet and **bake** until heated through and golden brown on top, about 20-25 minutes. Yield: 6 servings

Nutritional Analysis: 410 calories, 9 g fat, 4.5 g saturated fat, 20 mg cholesterol, 400 mg sodium, 70 g carbohydrates, 9 g fiber, 4 g sugar, 15 g protein.
