

Northern Kentucky Cattle Association Scholarship

Up to four \$500 Annual Scholarships will be awarded by the Northern KY Cattle Association. Two may be awarded to eligible Kenton County Residents and two to eligible Boone County residents at the discretion of the Northern Kentucky Cattle Association Board.

Eligibility

- 1. Applicant must be a senior in high school or older.
- 2. Applicant or their parent/guardian <u>must</u> be a Northern KY Cattle Association member <u>prior</u> <u>to</u> the submission of the scholarship application.
- 3. Applicant is strongly encouraged to pursue an ag-related field.

Documents required

- 1. A completed a scholarship application.
- 2. Four written essay answers to the questions on the current year application.
- 3. Proof of enrollment in the program where the scholarship will be used is required **before disbursement**.

Timeline

- 1. The application and essay must be received by the County Extension Office as indicated on the application no later than April 15 of the current year.
- 2. A selection committee will review and grade the applications (de-identified).
- 3. Scholarship awards will be sent out before September 1 of the application year, or when proof of enrollment is provided.
- 4. Scholarship winners will be invited to the Annual Membership meeting for recognition.

Selection Criteria

The answer to each of 4 questions will be given a score of 1 - 10 with 10 being the highest. Total score will be 0 - 40 possible points. Applicant with the highest score will receive the scholarship.
